Distraction thefts alert

Please be aware of some unscrupulous individuals operating a distraction theft. There have been a number of incidents in other force areas, where a group of people approached elderly ladies and offered them jewellery as a



'gift from God'. As they confuse the victim they remove their jewellery and leave them with various items of rings/necklaces of 'rubbish/fake' jewellery making off with the real jewellery. The group are described as Eastern European gypsy looking, two females and two males all aged around late 40's. They had dark hair and the women were wearing long skirts with a floral pattern. The group first asked directions making the victims believe they were lost and needed help. Their car was described as a black saloon with 4 doors one person said they thought it was hand painted. If you believe you have spotted them in action call it in as a 999 immediately.

We need to remember that 'criminals have no boundaries,' they could be in our area next, so please make sure that you pass this message on to friends, relatives, neighbours and colleagues

Farm Chemical Stores

You probably know that there are links between farm chemicals and the manufacture of improvised explosive devices. The bulk theft of these products should be viewed very seriously, especially with the high profile events occurring this year.

Please review the security of your chemical stores and seek advice if you have any concerns that you do not feel equipped to deal with. Please ensure that any chemicals that have exceeded "Useby" dates are disposed of. I'm sure you know that there are some older (withdrawn) chemicals still to be found in some farms, and that they can become unstable and a danger to you and your employees. Do You Recognise These People

Detectives are appealing for information from the public to identify two people they believe may have information which could assist them with an attempted burglary in Brickendon.



The incident happened between 10.45 am and 11.40am on Thursday June 7th when the offender(s) attempted to gain entry to the property by smashing a window. The second layer of glass did not break and offenders were then prevented from gaining entry to the property.

Detective Constable Dieter Sweeting, who is investigating the incident said: "Are you one of these people? Or do you recognise them? We believe they may have vital information which could assist our investigation. If you have any information at all, please get in touch with us as a matter of urgency."
