Seven Arrested as Police Target Criminals Using Our Roads

Police carried out a joint operation on Tuesday December 4th to target criminals using the county's roads to transport stolen goods and metal, making seven arrests.

The operation was carried out with Herts County Council Trading Standards and the Department for Work and Pensions (DWP). Officers targeted vehicles travelling on the A602, Westmill Road near Ware, and A119 at Stapleford using ANPR technology and police intercept vehicles, paying particular attention to vans and small lorries. The targeted vehicles were flagged down and their cargo checked for stolen goods and metal.

As part of the operation vehicles were also routinely checked for appropriate documentation, insurance and to ensure the safety and condition of the vehicles and that loads were at the required standard.

During the operation over 150 vehicles were stopped, seven arrests made and two vehicles were seized.

Nationwide Building Society scam

An local resident received a phone call from someone purporting to be from the Nationwide Building Society. The caller was in possession of all of the bank details, full name, and address and even had the date of birth. The caller requested that he place his bank card into the card reader and relate the access code given. This small but important piece of information would have given a bogus caller complete and total access to everything in that account.

Most of us have a good understanding of how people would like to try to part us from our hard earned cash, but if someone calls with so much private and personal information in place, even

those of us who are quite savvy are likely to be taken off guard. Please take care and if you are not expecting a call from your bank or building society treat it suspiciously. Tell the caller you are going to contact your bank to verify their call and ring them back. If it is a genuine call they will not mind you doing this.

Burglar alarm scam

Some burglar alarm companies are currently targeting residents in this area by telephoning them and making false claims to sell over priced products. They make the following claims:

They are working with the Police or the Council: This is not true! The police or Council are not working locally with any company in this capacity.

The alarm is free: You will be expected to sign up to a contract which can cost thousands of pounds. The Police only attend alarms they have fitted: This is totally untrue.

Another Phone Scam

You get a phone call saying that as you are a pensioner you are eligible for a payment of £1000 - to find out more, please press 5, or to finish call please press 9. I think that both of these are automatic dial in's on a premium rate line. There are variations on the call, like 'Eligible for Heating Grants' etc
